My current 8 week class of students have graduated and I am beginning to slot them into future community kirtan events. Shreya will be doing the response for two of my chants this coming Saturday, and Rick will be doing the response for Geetanjali. I also have Diana from the community accompanying me on the two English chants.

The 3 day kirtan bootcamp at Rivendell Centre on Bowen Island scheduled for July 17-20th is looking like it's full-steam ahead. I'm preparing to boost up my brain power in preparation for the intense teaching schedule by taking more brain-neurogenic friendly supplements like coconut oil, MCT, and will get some Brahmi soon.

The curriculum is intended to get total beginners (and non) up to a level of musicianship where they are comfortable with playing the kirtan scales, in different keys, on time (hopefully) and on pitch (hopefully again).
