

## My Online Western Kirtan Music Education Training

I've been working hard (as much as I can manage) on completing my online kirtan training before the end of 2025. Back in 2023, I created a curriculum which provides a music education in Western music basics while teaching folks how to play the harmonium, sing on pitch and on time, and how to lead kirtan.

It's taken me many years to navigate the technical challenges of creating music scores which provide a clear map of the chants, creating a keyboard methodology that makes it easier to learn how to play the harmonium, and the needed website steps.

These recent weeks involved converting the diagrams that I used in my in-person course handouts into my own versions that I can use in my online training without worry about copyrights.

So I learned how to use Adobe Illustrator to create the graphics. There's an example on the left. It took a lot of frustration and banging my head against the wall, as I didn't really know how to use Illustrator. Thanks to people sharing their knowledge on the Internet, slowly slowly I learnt enough skills to do the diagrams.

I'm planning to have 9 beautiful chants included in the online course. I'm blessed to develop an innovative approach to learning which, I think, will supercharge peoples' ability to learn how to lead kirtan. There's lots of details - from each note, each bar, each melody, and each transition. Great for beginners, especially people who have never touched a keyboard before.
